

# WINGS 'N THING 2006

## CAMPING RULES

1. Each youth group is to provide their own adult leadership at **ALL** times during the weekend. The adult leadership is responsible for the behavior of their group.
2. All adults and youths are to remain south of the fence between the campground and the taxiway/runway (*active airport area*). **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Anyone found beyond the fence will be sent home immediately.
3. **NO GROUND FIRES.** Propane stoves may be used if necessary.
4. All campers are to remain in their own camping area at all times. Do **NOT** walk or run through other camping areas.
5. Lights out and QUIET TIME begins at 11:00 p.m. each night.
6. All vehicles are to remain in the campground area and **NOT** driven to the meals or to the Wings 'n Things exhibit area.
7. First Aid is available at the medical trailer at the Florida Air Museum.
8. Each camping group must have their camping area reviewed for proper clean up prior to leaving Sun 'n Fun grounds. Wings 'n Things personnel will be available for check out at the registration building.
9. All youth groups camping Saturday night will be responsible for their own meals starting with Saturday night dinner.
10. Wristbands are required for all registered youth and adults at Saturday breakfast, lunch and all activities. Wristbands will be distributed to unit leaders at camping registration on Friday.
